Grade 3/4 News

This month, the grade 3's and 4's have been improving their reading, speaking, and listening skills by participating in Readers Theatre activities. The students have also been talking about decision making in health and the best ways for a group to make a decision. In Science, they have started learning about soil and are just starting to research how animals or insects depend on soil. They have enjoyed all the snow and made the best of some cold temperatures. Let's hope that the cold temperatures are mostly over as we start longer days and are looking forward to spring.



Grade 5/6 News

Even with a very cold January, our Grade 5/6 class has been busy learning and growing! In Math, Grade 5 students wrapped up their multiplication unit and have moved into division. We are exploring a variety of strategies, including the box method, to build understanding and confidence with problem-solving. In English Language Arts, we have continued our reading groups, building comprehension and discussion skills. In Writing, students have been studying the difference between formal and informal letters and are currently working on an informal email as part of our writing project. In Social Studies, we are studying the relationship between people and the land, with a current focus on Canada's provinces and territories. We are looking forward to a great February filled with continued learning and growth!

Grade 7/8 News

In January the 7/8 class worked on designing and creating Earthquake Resistant Buildings. The students built their design and then invited the 1/2 class to watch as they tested the buildings. Each building was excellent and none fell apart! Students have also been continuing to design items to be 3D printed and each student will receive a keychain with their name on it. In Language Arts we are finishing a novel study about the 1936 Berlin Olympic Games as well as working on writing. The 7/8 class is also looking forward to touring Carlton on February 12.




Band News


